FACTS FOUND

1. KOMATSU AZZURRO the right of way boat was extensively damaged at the start of the Cabbage Tree Island Race by Eve that failed to keep clear. See Protest Reve; Azzurro; Eve 17-11-2017.
2. Despite extensive work on and effort by Komatsu Azzurro owners and contractors the boat was not repaired in time to safely sail in the Bird Island Race.

CONCLUSION

1. KOMATSU AZZURRO was unable to start in the Bird Island Race through no fault of her own.
2. KOMATSU AZZURRO is entitled to redress.

RULES APPLICABLE

DECISION

KOMATSU AZZURRO is granted redress, being the average of her points in races 1, 2 and 3 in IRC, ORC & PHS divisions, of the Blue Water Point Score.
