Permanent Amendment 1 to the Sailing Program

General Conditions of Sailing

2. Advertising

Add:

- 2.1 All boats in the Blue Water Pointscore shall carry and operate a tracking unit supplied by the Organising Authority.

17.3 Changes to the Racing Rules of Sailing

Delete 17.3 and replace with:

17.3 Changes to the Racing Rules of Sailing

RRS 32.2: Is amended by adding: In Short Haul and Short Ocean Races if IC Flag "S" is displayed on or near the mark designated, then a boat shall round/pass the mark as required (looping not necessary) and proceed directly to the Finish.

RRS 41: Whilst racing, a boat may retrieve data from any page of the CYCA website (www.cyca.com.au) or any event website controlled by CYCA, even if that page is not publicly available. Boats in the Blue Water Pointscore races may retrieve data from the standings pages of the from <http://bwps.cyca.com.au/standings/lite> and or retrieve data from the text-based feeds provided at <http://yb.tl/Links/BWP2018> even if those pages are not publicly available. During the race a boat shall not contact, or be in contact with, any person or private entity using any medium to receive private forecasts, tactical advise or information customised for a particular boat or group of boats, however a boat may obtain assistance in the form of any readily available commercial meteorological or hydrographical information regardless of cost. Amends RRS 41(c).

RRS 51: A boat with movable or variable ballast (within the meaning of those terms in the Special Regulations) may move the ballast for the purpose of changing trim or stability.

RRS 52: RRS 52 does not apply to the adjustment and operation of sails or the adjustment of movable appendages on any boat.

Blue Water Pointscore Sailing Instructions

4. Entry

Delete 4.1 and replace with:

4. Entry

- 4.1 The following shall be supplied to the Sailing Office no later than 1200 hours on the **Monday** prior to the race:
- a) Completed Entry (made online through the CYCA website www.cyca.com.au);
 - b) Australian Sailing Special Regulations Equipment Audit Form for Race Category 2 or higher category;
 - c) Verification of Stability as per paragraph 8.5 of the General Conditions of Racing of this Sailing Program;
 - d) Verification of construction requirements (refer Special Regulations 3.03);
 - e) Current Rating Certificate (if applicable);
 - f) 406 EPIRB Certificate;
 - g) Life Raft Inspection Certificate(s);
 - h) CYCA Radio Inspection Certificate;
 - i) **Long Range Marine Radio Operators Certificates of Proficiency (LROCP)** for two crew members;
 - j) Provide First Aid Certificates for two crew members;
 - k) Australian Sailing Sea Safety and Survival Course Certificates for 30% of crew members;
 - l) Declaration of Crew Experience (through the crew list in the online entry) for 50% of crew members (refer Special Regulations 2.04);
 - m) Crew list (to be completed in the online entry) showing Name, Address, Age, Weight, Australian Sailing number, PLB number, Jacket Colour and NOK contact details for each crew member and two 24 hour emergency boat contacts including phone numbers (not being persons sailing);
 - n) General Disclaimer and Acknowledgement of Rights Form to be signed by each crew member;
 - o) Colour photograph of the boat under sail, no older than 12 months and suitable for search and rescue purposes. This may be a digital photograph of a size not less than 6cm by 6cm with a resolution not less than 400 DPI.
 - p) Satphone declaration
 - q) Marine legal liability insurance policy (refer SI 2.4); and
 - r) Entry Fee.

7. Radio Schedules & Satphone

Add:

- 7.17 The Race Committee may require a boat on which a tracking unit fails or ceases to operate to establish a separate position reporting schedule with by telephone to the Race Committee on 0419 288 323. A direction by the Race Committee under this SI 7.17 will apply to the boat to which it is directed whether or not the transmission is received and shall take immediate effect.
