An exciting corporate event awaits you at the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia. With a rich sailing history, the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia is regarded as one of the World's premier Yacht Clubs. It is also home to the world's most iconic ocean race – the Rolex Sydney Hobart Yacht Race.

The CYCA owns a fleet of 10 identical 7m keel boats which can accommodate up to 4 guest per yacht. These yachts are fast, stable and fun, with an open skiff style cockpit meaning they are easy to sail and great for teamwork development.

Corporate Sailing is offered every Friday at the CYCA from October to April each year.

CYCA Corporate Sailing Experience

The CYCA owns a fleet of Elliott 7m keel boats. The Elliott Marine 7m keel boat was selected for its durability, functionality and sail configuration.

These yachts are fast, stable and fun, with an open skiff style cockpit meaning they are easy to sail and great for teamwork development.

The yachts are 7m in length, making it ideal for adults of all ages and skill level. The yachts can accommodate up to four guests as well as an on board instructor for sailing courses, corporate events and regattas.

With a fleet of 10 identical yachts, the CYCA Youth Sailing Academy continually delivers world class coaching and sail training for their members and participants as well as host world class sailing events for international competitors.

1400 - 1415 Guests arrive @ CYCA

1415 - 1430 Introduction & Safety Briefing

1430 - 1445 Elliott Intro & Dock off

1445 - 1500 Practice

1500 - 1630 Fleet Racing Series (up to 6 short races)

1630 - 1700 Return to CYCA Marina

1700 - 1730 Presentation and Wrap up

Fleet Racing is a race where all boats compete against each other. The race consists of a 3 minute pre-start and a windward/leeward race course. Teams score 1 point for each place in each race (1st = 1pt). The team with the lowest point score wins!

FAQs

What if I have never sailed before?

No prior sailing experience is necessary. It is a new sport for most of the participants and is a fun activity for everyone to learn together as a team. It is accessible to all levels of athleticism.

What is the sailing area?

On-board instructors will sail the boats out of the CYCA Marina into Sydney Harbour. From there, the course will be setup in the vicinity of Rushcutters Bay, just outside the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia. Packages can be tailored to suit your needs with additional sailing areas including Athol Bay, Manly, Rose Bay, Kirribilli & Barangaroo

What should I wear and bring?

Check the weather, and dress appropriately! Remember: it is always cooler on the water, and there is a chance you will get wet. Rain or shine, we will sail!

- Athletic enclosed shoes that can get wet or sandals with a heel strap (Crocs are great!)
- Clothing that will dry quickly. Athletic shorts and a T-shirt work great. No jeans!
- Fleece depending on forecast
- Hat

Sunscreen, lifejackets and gloves will be available to all participants.

Where do I keep my valuables when sailing?

All valuables and possessions may be safely stored in a locker in the clubhouse. Each sailboat has limited dry storage although waterproof bags will be available to allow participants to carry cameras etc. during the experience. Extra clothing can be kept on a coach/safety boat. If an item is required on the boat with you, it can be placed in a plastic bag and stored down below on the sailboat. Cell phones are strongly discouraged on-board the sailboats.

Liability

Every participant must complete a liability waiver in order to participate in the event. Liability forms will be distributed via PDF before the event and will be available onsite the day of the event.

Safety

All water sport activities contain an element of risk and it should be understood that each person participates at his/her own risk.

We make sure that our safety procedures are strictly adhered to because corporate sailing clients generally have very limited sailing experience. Before going out on the water, participants are briefed on all safety procedures and any dangers to watch for. All participants are required to wear lifejackets while on CYCA docks and on-board the sailboats.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited before and during all sailing activities.
