



COVIDSAFE PLAN FOR SAILING

While community sport and recreational activities are permitted under NSW COVID-19 Restrictions, the Public Health Order has strict conditions with which competitors and the club must comply. To ensure we are in compliance, CYCA asks that all competitors adhere to the following guidelines to ensure we are able to continue racing in a safe, compliant and enjoyable manner.

Prior to racing:

- All crew members must be fully vaccinated to participate in CYCA races unless they are exempt.
- A crew list must be submitted via the online entry system by the designated times in the Sailing Program prior to racing.
- The owner must sign an online declaration confirming all crew on the submitted crew list have been fully vaccinated.
- Crew are to be advised to stay home if displaying any symptoms of the virus. Symptoms include cough, sore throat, shortness of breath and fever.

In the clubhouse or the John Messenger building:

- All members and guests must sign in using the Service NSW QR Code prior to entering the Clubhouse or the John Messenger Building.
- All members and guests must be fully vaccinated in order to enter the CYCA Clubhouse.
- Please be aware the Club has a reduced capacity and social distancing must be adhered to whilst inside the Clubhouse. If the maximum number has been reached and you are denied entry, please be understanding- our staff are only doing their job.
- Hand sanitiser is available throughout the Clubhouse.
- Masks must be worn in the inside areas of the Clubhouse except when eating or drinking.

On the CYCA Marina:

- All persons on the marina must be fully vaccinated (staff may request verification of this).
- All persons must sign in using the Service NSW QR Code.
- Do not gather in groups on the dock.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres where reasonably practicable

On water- CYCA recommends:

- Avoid physical contact.
- No sharing of clothing, lifejackets, eating/drinking (Cups, bottles, cutlery etc).
- Extra cleaning and sanitisation of high touch areas such as winch handles, steering wheel, hatch ways, galley and toilet facilities.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres where reasonably practicable.
- Avoid any shared travel arrangements such as carpooling.
- Boats should consider their own COVID Safe Plan pertaining to their vessel.
