PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Conflict of interest

Protest Committee members declared that they had no conflicts of interest and no party objected to the members hearing the protest

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Bliss delivered a Hearing Request containing the information required by rule 61.2 to the race office within the protest time limit.
- 2. Bliss hailed 'protest' at the time of the incident.
- 3. Bliss displayed a red flag a few minutes after the incident
- 4. Both boats suffered superficial damage to their topsides and no crew member of either boat was injured.

CONCLUSION AND RULES THAT APPLY

- A. Bliss did not display a red flag at the first reasonable opportunity as required by rule 61.1(a).
- B. The circumstances of rule 61.1(a)(4) regarding serious damage do not apply.
- C. The protest is invalid.

DECISION

The hearing is closed in accordance with rule 63.5.
